Access Improvement Model (AIM) program

A recent study published in the *Annals of Family Medicine* reveals that implementing quality improvement strategies can improve patient outcomes, reduce health-care costs, and lower rates of hospitalizations, emergency department visits and specialist referrals. The Access Improvement Model (AIM) program is designed to help primary care teams develop and improve their skills in quality improvement, change management, and team building. AIM is currently working with two pilot sites and two potential clinics have expressed their interest in joining upcoming cohorts. POSTGRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION Faculty and Staff Awards Program

Postgraduate Medical Education (PGME) has launched a Faculty and Staff Awards Program to recognize exceptional contributions made towards the education and career development of PGME residents and fellows. The program has three categories of faculty awards and one category of staff award. **Faculty awards:** There are three categories of faculty awards named PGME Awards.

- 1. Medical Education
- 2. Leadership Development
- 3. Professionalism, Advocacy, and Social Accountability Two awards will be given annually in each category. One award will be nominated by a program director, and the other by a resident or fellow.

Two of our studies have been accepted for presentation at the upcoming North American Primary Care Research Group Practice-Based Research Network (NAPCRG PBRN) conference, which will be held from May 30-June 1 in Bethesda, Maryland.

The first study, conducted by **Singer A, Kosowan L,** Mirzakhani F, Adegbite E., is, "Prevalence and burden of mental health conditions in primary care populations."
