



QI, Research & Educational Scholarship Excellence Award

Purpose: To acknowledge faculty who have made (an) outstanding contribution(s) to education scholarship and knowledge building in family medicine within the last three years. The contribution(s) are expected to exemplify innovation and impact in any of the following categories: Quality Improvement, Research, and Educational Scholarship

Eligibility: Any individual with a Department of Medicine (DFM) faculty appointment is eligible for nomination. Up to three (3) awards are available each year (one in each category). Previous award winners cannot win the award again in the same category but a faculty member can receive an award in another category over time.

Selection: The selection committee will consider the following criteria:

- Demonstration of innovative contribution(s) in one of the following areas: Quality Improvement, Research or Educational Scholarship
- Evidence of impact and/or dissemination may be in any of the following areas:
 - Grants
 - Presentations (lectures, posters, oral papers, workshops, seminars, symposia, panel discussions, web based, social media, dramatic presentations, etc.)
 - Publication in peer-reviewed journals or other peer-reviewed repositories
 - Book chapters etc. (Participating in a group as an author contributing a chapter to a book)

Process: Nominations can be made by any faculty or staff member of the DFM, including self-nomination. The nominations and applications will be considered by the DFM Promotion and Awards Committee. The nominator is responsible for the collection and submission of the award application/nomination package and informing the nominee of their nomination.

Application Package: The following will be required as part of the candidate's application and must be emailed to dfmfaculty@umanitoba.ca by the deadline.

1. A completed form
2. Two letters of support
3. A current and complete curriculum vitae (CV)
4. Additional material documenting evidence of excellence may be submitted

Timeline:

- March 6, 2024: Submissions open
- April 24, 2024: Application submission deadline.
If this date falls on a weekend or statutory holiday, the deadline moves to the next business day.
- May 24, 2024: Presentation of award at Inspire Annual DFM Awards
Announcements of award recipients are made first in confidence to the recipient prior to May 24, 2024 and then publicly at a later date.

Notes: Recipient will be recognized on the Departmental Newsletter and website.
