BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:

The Undergrad Education Coordinator, Palliative Medicine is responsible for organizing, scheduling and overseeing the provision of lectures, tutorials, selective rotations and evaluations for undergraduate medical students in the area of Palliative Medicine. This individual works with the Director, Undergraduate Education, to ensure that the educational sessions provided are conducted in a manner that is consistent with the mission and policies of the Department of Family Medicine and its Undergraduate Education Committee.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

In addition to the duties and responsibilities related to general teaching, the incumbent is responsible for the following related to this position:

1) Administrative

- Implements educational activities and curriculum for undergraduate students in the area of Palliative Medicine
- Receives and prioritizes requests for lectures and tutorials and recruits presenters
- Receives requests for selective rotations and recruits preceptors

- Is responsible for reviewing and evaluating the content and quality of teaching and making improvements in same.
