DOCUMENT NAME: RESIDENT PROGRESS SUBCOMMITTEE DECISION

DESCRIPTION:

This document is prepared by the Site Education Director for presentation to the Resident Progress Subcommittee following the 6-month periodic review **(at T6, T12, T18, T24)**, and at such time where the Resident Progress Subcommittee must deliberate on all decisions regarding Resident progress, including: advancement from PGY1 to PGY2; completion of training; remediation, probation, or dismissal; accommodation of residents with disabilities, and educational handover. Following the Resident Progress Subcommittee Decision, the document is shared with the Resident, and thereafter submitted through VENTIS to PGME by completing and submitting the VENTIS RoRP, as required by PGME. The VENTIS RoRP is generated ad hoc by the Site Education Director, and populated using information from the final Resident Progress Sub-Committee Decision. At the T24 review, the Site Education Director will provide a completed Resident Progress Sub-Committee Decision Form and Residency Program Requirements Tracking Form to the Resident Progress Subcommittee for decision. This will lead to the VENTIS Completion of Training eform.
