What if I attended a similar Core Curriculum course elsewhere? Can I receive credit for that course?

No, unfortunately you must take the core curriculum courses for the University of Manitoba. While the Postgraduate Medical Education office recognizes that some courses may be similar, you are now a registered University of Manitoba trainee and must take the mandatory core curriculum sessions designed for University of Manitoba trainees.

New Core Curriculum sessions as of July 1, 2021:

1. Teaching Development Program

This new Teaching Development Program is replacing TDP 1 and TDP 2. Residents who have completed TDP 1 and 2 do not have to complete this new course. Any residents who have only finished TDP 1 or TDP 2 will now have to complete the new Teaching Development Program.

This course covers the fundamentals residents need to teach medical students in the clinical setting including:

- 1) Learner Orientation
- 2) Assessment of Learners
- 3) Clinical Teaching
- 4) Giving Feedback
- 5) Learner in Difficulty

This course has been completely redone using new software and includes new videos featuring local learners.
