



Building Stronger Connections: Insights from Teaching Site Survey

The Department of Family Medicine sent out a Teaching Site Survey to gather feedback from teaching sites across Manitoba.

Goal: To better understand the strengths, challenges, and priorities involved in supporting distributed medical education.

- A sample of teaching sites participated in the survey, representing urban, rural, and northern teaching clinics.
- Responses collected were confidential.

Outcomes:

Key Strengths	Key Challenges	Reason Why Sites Continue Teaching
Clear communication, well-organized rotations, responsive administrative support staff, positive learner experiences, and faculty collaboration.	Limited capacity, uneven engagement, need for improved recognition, and gaps in feedback processes.	To support community recruitment and sustainability. They find teaching to be professionally rewarding.

Insights from this survey will help guide future planning, partnership development, and site expansion efforts aligned with the government's mandate to increase training capacity.
