The Physician Assistant (PA) will work under the supervision of licensed physicians, providing direct patient care, supporting diagnostic and treatment services, and promoting overall wellness. This role offers a unique opportunity to practice with professional autonomy within scope, contribute to an evolving care model, and be part of a progressive clinical team.

Responsibilities:

- Conduct comprehensive patient interviews, obtain detailed medical histories, and perform physical examinations.

- Prescribe medications within the authorized scope of practice and under physician supervision.
